

Minutes and proceedings of a Meeting of the Upwood Parish Council held in the National Schools on **Tuesday the 7th day of May 1929.**

Telephone.

A letter was read from the Telephone Development Association with reference to a Call Office for the village. Resolved that the matter be deferred pending further information from the Telephone Development Association.

Hill Farm Lease.

The Clerk reported that the Lease of the Hill Farm Allotments would expire on the 11th day of October next. It was resolved that the Council negotiate with Lord De Ramsey's Trustees for a new

lease and that they be asked "That having regard to the present value of agricultural produce they could see their way to reduce the rent to the original amount of twenty pounds".

Hedges.

Resolved that the Hedge at the corner of Ramsey Road on Hill Farm be lowered and the work be entrusted to Mr. J. Gaunt.

Allotment Leases.

The Clerk presented a bill from Mr. Radway for legal costs of Allotment Lease and Counterpart amounting to £7.3.4

Legal Charges.

Resolved on the proposition of Mr. Sinclair seconded by Mr. Townsend that liability for this charge be repudiated, and that the bill be referred back to Mr. Radway, as the Council have no funds for such matters as these.

Hedges.

Resolved that the Parish Hedges be cut and trimmed under the superintendence of the Chairman and the Rev. E. F. Hemming.

Water Supply.

Proposed by Mr. Sinclair seconded by the Rev. E. F. Hemming that Mr. Burton be paid 7/6 for the locking and unlocking the Village Pump during the recent drought. Carried.

Roads.

Resolved that the Clerk write a letter to the Hunts. County Council complaining of the deplorable state of the roads in the Parish, and ask if same cannot be put in reasonable repair and order.

Allotments.

The Audit of the Councils Allotments was held the same evening and the Clerk reported that Rents received amounted to £32.14.1
